## Privacy Policy

Perth Digital (“we,” “our,” or “us”) is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how your personal information is collected, used, and disclosed by Perth Digital.

This Privacy Policy applies to our website, and its associated subdomains (collectively, our “Service”) alongside our application, Perth Digital. By accessing or using our Service, you signify that you have read, understood, and agree to our collection, storage, use, and disclosure of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy and our Terms of Service.

## Definitions and key terms

To help explain things as clearly as possible in this Privacy Policy, every time any of these terms are referenced, are strictly defined as:

- **Cookie:** small amount of data generated by a website and saved by your web browser. It is used to identify your browser, provide analytics, and remember information about you, such as your language preference or login information.
- **Company:** when this policy mentions “Company,” “we,” “us,” or “our,” it refers to NFJ Digital Solutions Company Limited, (94 Xuan Thuy, Thao Dien, Thu Duc City, Ho Chi Minh City), that is responsible for your information under this Privacy Policy.
- **Country:** where Perth Digital or the owners/founders of Perth Digital are based, in this case is Vietnam
- **Customer:** refers to the company, organisation or person that signs up to use the Perth Digital Service to manage the relationships with your consumers or service users.
- **Device:** any internet connected device such as a phone, tablet, computer or

any other device that can be used to visit Perth Digital and use the services.

- **IP address:** Every device connected to the Internet is assigned a number known as an Internet protocol (IP) address. These numbers are usually assigned in geographic blocks. An IP address can often be used to identify the location from which a device is connecting to the Internet.
- **Personnel:** refers to those individuals who are employed by Perth Digital or are under contract to perform a service on behalf of one of the parties.
- **Personal Data:** any information that directly, indirectly, or in connection with other information – including a personal identification number – allows for the identification or identifiability of a natural person.

## When does Perth Digital use end-user information from third parties?

Perth Digital will collect End User Data necessary to provide the Perth Digital services to our customers. End users may voluntarily provide us with information they have

made available on social media websites. If you provide us with any such information, we may collect publicly available information from the social media websites you have indicated. You can control how much of your information social media websites make public by visiting these websites and changing your privacy settings.

## **When does Perth Digital use customer information from third parties?**

If your IP address is shared, it may be used to estimate general location and other technographics such as connection speed, whether you have visited the website in a shared location, and type of the device used to visit the website. They may aggregate information about our advertising and what you see on the website and then provide auditing, research and reporting for us and our advertisers.

We may also disclose personal and non-personal information about you to government or law enforcement officials or private parties as we, in our sole discretion, believe necessary or appropriate in order to respond to claims, legal process (including subpoenas), to protect our rights and interests or those of a third party, the safety of the public or any person, to prevent or stop any illegal, unethical, or legally actionable activity, or to otherwise comply with applicable court orders, laws, rules and regulations.

## **Where and when is information collected from customers and end users?**

Perth Digital will collect personal information that you submit to us. We may also receive personal information about you from third parties as described above.

## **How Do We Use The Information We Collect?**

Any of the information we collect from you may be used in one of the following ways:

- To personalise your experience (your information helps us to better respond to your individual needs)
- To improve our website (we continually strive to improve our website offerings based on the information and feedback we receive from you)
- To improve customer service (your information helps us to more effectively respond to your customer service requests and support needs)
- To process transactions
- To administer a contest, promotion, survey or other site feature
- To send periodic emails

## How Do We Use Your Email Address?

By submitting your email address on this website, you agree to receive emails from us. You can cancel your participation in any of these email lists at any time by clicking on the opt-out link or other unsubscribe option that is included in the respective email. We only send emails to people who have authorised us to contact them, either directly, or through a third party. We do not send unsolicited commercial emails, because we hate spam as much as you do. By submitting your email address, you also agree to allow us to use your email address for customer audience targeting on sites like Facebook, where we display custom advertising to specific people who have opted-in to receive communications from us. Email addresses submitted only through the order processing page will be used for the sole purpose of sending you information and updates pertaining to your order. ## How Long Do We Keep Your Information?

We keep your information only so long as we need it to provide Perth Digital to you

and fulfil the purposes described in this policy. This is also the case for anyone that we share your information with and who carries out services on our behalf. When we no longer need to use your information and there is no need for us to keep it to comply with our legal or regulatory obligations, we'll either remove it from our systems or depersonalise it so that we can't identify you.

## **How Do We Protect Your Information?**

We implement a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information when you place an order or enter, submit, or access your personal information. We offer the use of a secure server. All supplied sensitive/credit information is transmitted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology and then encrypted into our Payment gateway providers database only to be accessible by those authorised with special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential. After a transaction, your private information (credit cards, social security numbers, financials, etc.) is never kept on file. We cannot, however, ensure or warrant the absolute security of any information you transmit to Perth Digital or guarantee that your information on the Service may not be accessed, disclosed, altered, or destroyed by a breach of any of our physical, technical, or managerial safeguards.

## **Could my information be transferred to other countries?**

Perth Digital is incorporated in Vietnam. Information collected via our website, through direct interactions with you, or from the use of our help services may be transferred from time to time to our offices or personnel, or to third parties, located throughout the world, and may be viewed and hosted anywhere in the world, including countries that may not have laws of general applicability regulating the use and transfer of such data. ## **Is the information collected through the Perth Digital Service secure?**

We take precautions to protect the security of your information. We have physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to help safeguard, prevent unauthorised access, maintain data security, and correctly use your information. However, neither people nor security systems are foolproof, including encryption systems. In addition, people can commit intentional crimes, make mistakes or fail to follow policies. Therefore, while we use reasonable efforts to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security. If applicable law imposes any non-disclaimable duty to protect your personal information, you agree that intentional misconduct will be the standard used to measure our compliance with that duty.

## **Can I update or correct my information?**

The rights you have to request updates or corrections to the information Perth Digital collects depend on your relationship with Perth Digital. Personnel may update or correct their information as detailed in our internal company employment policies.

You consent to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in connection with any action or dispute arising between the parties under or in connection with this Privacy Policy except for those individuals who may have rights to make claims under Privacy Shield, or the Swiss-US framework.

The laws of Vietnam, excluding its conflicts of law rules, shall govern this Agreement and your use of the website. Your use of the website may also be subject to other local, state, national, or international laws.

By using Perth Digital or contacting us directly, you signify your acceptance of this

Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to this Privacy Policy, you should not engage with our website, or use our services. ## **Information about General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)**

We may be collecting and using information from you if you are from the European Economic Area (EEA), and in this section of our Privacy Policy, we are going to explain exactly how and why this data is collected, and how we maintain this data under protection from being replicated or used in the wrong way.

## What is GDPR?

GDPR is an EU-wide privacy and data protection law that regulates how EU residents' data is protected by companies and enhances the control the EU residents have over their personal data.

## Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how Perth Digital and its affiliates (collectively "Perth Digital", "we", "us", and "ours"), use cookies and similar technologies to recognize you when you visit our website, including without limitation Perth.digital and any related URLs, mobile or localised versions and related domains / subdomains ("Websites"). It explains what these technologies are and why we use them, as well as the choices for how to control them.

## What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer or other internet connected device in order to identify your browser, provide analytics, and remember information about you such as your language preference or login information. They're completely safe and can't be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your device.

## Why do we use cookies?

We use first party and/or third party cookies on our website for various purposes such as:

- To facilitate the operation and functionality of our website;
- To improve your experience of our website and make navigating around them quicker and easier;
- To allow us to make a bespoke user experience for you and for us to understand what is useful or of interest to you;
- To analyse how our website is used and how best we can customise it;
- To identify future prospects and personalise marketing and sales interactions with it;
- To facilitate the tailoring of online advertising to your interests.

## What type of cookies does Perth Digital use?

Cookies can either be session cookies or persistent cookies. A session cookie expires automatically when you close your browser. A persistent cookie will remain until it expires or you delete your cookies. Expiration dates are set in the cookies themselves; some may expire after a few minutes while others may expire after multiple years. Cookies placed by the website you're visiting are called "first party cookies".

Strictly Necessary cookies are necessary for our website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are essential in order to enable you to navigate around the website and use its features. If you remove or disable these cookies, we cannot guarantee that you will be able to use our website.

We use the following types of cookies in our website:

### Essential Cookies
